




Obuse

Obuse is located in the northern part of Nagano Prefecture. It is famous for the Hokusai Museum, which houses the works of the artist Kastushika Hokusai. Jigokudani Yaen Koen

Jigokudani Yaen Koen is a park that allows people to observe monkeys up close in their natural habitat, and is the only place in the world where wild monkeys bathe in hot springs. Because the monkeys bathe in the hot spring during winter when the area is covered in snow, they are affectionately called snow monkeys.



It takes 25 minutes by direct bus from Nozawa Onsen to JR liyama station, about 35 minutes by express bus to ShigaKogen base, 35 minutes on foot

Shibu Onsen

Shibu Onsen is a hot spring town with a history of over 1300 years. You can bask in the old-fashioned atmosphere while walking along cobblestone streets lined with wooden ryokans. In addition to the nine public baths around town, you can also visit traditional game parlors and shooting galleries.* Nine public baths are available for guests only.



KANAZAWA

Crab auctions are held at Shinminato Kittokito Market from September to May, where red snow crabs are lined up like a red carpet. You can see the auction by advance reservation and eat freshly boiled crab.



Kanazawa

In Kanazawa, you can enjoy the historic landscape reminiscent of the Edo Period over 400 years ago. One of Japan's "Three Great Gardens," Kenrokuen, is located here. You can purchase traditional craft items such as Kutani ware and Wajima lacquer and enjoy fresh seafood.



Shirakawa-qo

Shirakawa-go is a village located in the northern part of Gifu Prefecture and is a famous World Heritage site. It is very beautiful from February to March when the village is covered and snow and illuminated at night. There are restaurants, accommodations, hot springs, and other facilities nearby.







Zenkoji Temple is said to have been built about 1400 years ago and is visited by many people from all over the country. The main hall is designated as a National Treasure, has high cultural value, and has many places of interest.
